- 3 Students choose books to read from personalized reading lists in their targeted Lexile range.

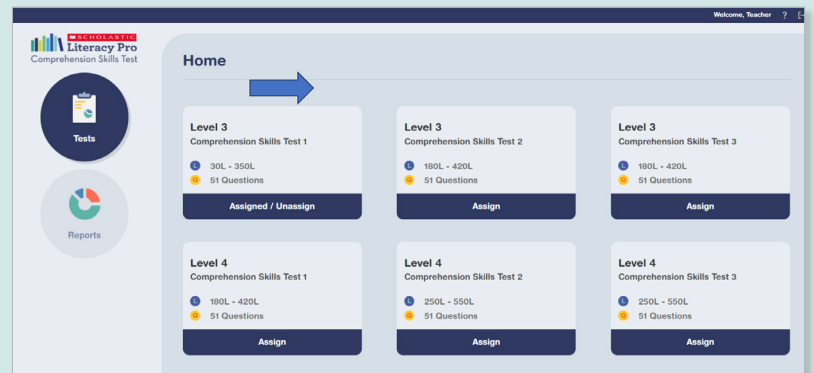
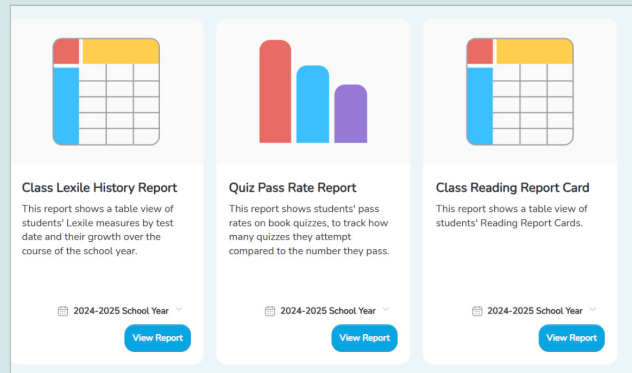

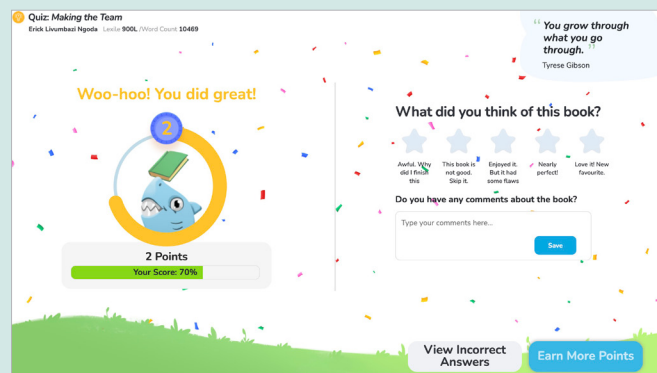
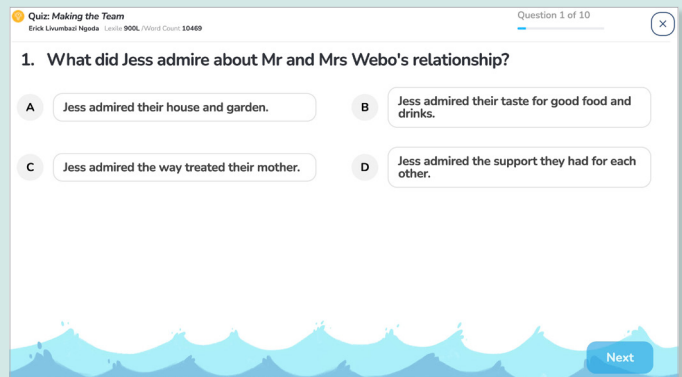
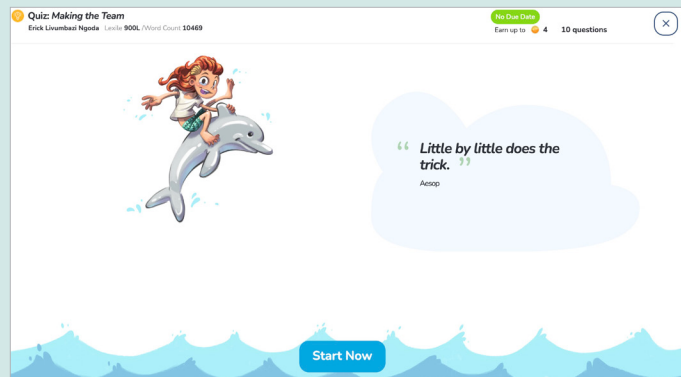
The assessment uses a variety of engaging question types to measure how well students understand, analyze, and apply what they read.
