What You Need:

- two yogurt pots
- soil
- two small plants
- small bottle of water



What You Do:

- Fill the yogurt pots with soil.
- Put a plant in each pot.
- Sprinkle a little water on each plant.
- Put one plant in a warm, sunny place.
- Put the other plant in a dark place.
- Sprinkle a little water on the plant in the sunny place each day for a week. Do not overwater your plant.



What You Should Notice:

The plant in the sunny place will live and grow. The plant in the dark place will die.
