

Levers

Concept: You apply force to a lever to make it work.

What You Need:

- desk or tabletop
- heavy dictionary or thick book
- ruler

What You Do:

- Lay the ruler on the tabletop with a quarter of it hanging over the edge.
- Put the book on the other end of the ruler.
- Press down on the part of the ruler that is sticking out and see if you can lift the book.
- Move the book a little closer to the edge of the tabletop by pulling on the ruler.
- Press the ruler down again.
- Do this several times until the book is at the edge of the tabletop.

What You Should Notice:

The closer the book gets to the edge, the easier it is to lift.
